Process:

The project shows evidence of a logical thought process for gathering information, processing data, and drawing conclusions. Process skills such as observation, measurement, inference, communication, etc. are used.

Understanding:

The student can articulate or demonstrate the ideas that she or he learned while doing the project. The student can reflect on how the project might be expanded or changed in the future.

Creativity/Child Centered:

The project reflects the child's interest. The project topic is unique or the student's approach to the topic is creative. If not unique, how much time, effort, and creativity did the student use to explain the topic.

Presentation:

The project is pleasing to the eye. Information is presented in an understandable sequence. Charts, graphs or tables are clear. The presentation is age appropriate. It is NOT required, but if there is an additional written explanation, such as a journal or log, student learning is reflected.
